\$1,000 College Scholarship Application

Guidelines:

1. Applicant must be a Preble County resident.
2. Scholarship candidate must be furthering their education in the field of agriculture or natural resources.
3. Candidate must be attending an accredited college and enrolled full-time in a two- or four-year degree program.
4. The scholarship is available to any college undergraduate entering their sophomore year or above.
5. **A current, official transcript must accompany the application. Two letters of recommendation will also be accepted.**
6. The \$1,000 scholarship will be paid directly to the Bursar's office of the winner's college prior to the fall 2021 term.
7. The scholarship is based on grade point average, field of study, community involvement and applicant's future goals.
8. This scholarship is offered on a nondiscriminatory basis without regard to race, color, national origin, sex, age, marital status or handicap.
9. Scholarship will not be awarded to the immediate families of SWCD board members or staff.
10. The Preble SWCD reserves the right to not award the scholarship if there are no qualified applicants.
11. Application and supporting materials must be returned to the District Office at 2789 US Rt. 35 E, West Alexandria, OH by **3:30 p.m., April 2, 2021**. Late applications will not be considered.
