We are pleased to offer your child the chance to attend 2019 Preble County Conservation Day Camp. This event, sponsored by the Preble Soil and Water Conservation District, is designed to get children OUTSIDE and LEARNING about how their daily actions affect water, wildlife, soil, and even the people around us. Last year was our third annual camp, with 119 attendees. We have heard rave reviews from campers, parents, and volunteers. We hope to reach 132 campers this year!

While at camp, your child will be supervised by a staff of adults and teen counselors. Our many staffers will guide your child through hands-on activities while maintaining a positive learning environment. A first aide attendant will be on hand each day to handle the scrapes and bruises that sometimes come with outdoor learning. A picnic-style lunch will be provided daily.

Campers will participate in several conservation-related activities each day, led by local instructors. We strive for sessions to be an equal balance of fun and education. Activities will be planned to help your child piece together how conservation fits into their daily lives.
